

Resident / Tenant Access to Essential Services

What's Happening?

Some residents/tenants require access to essential services such as foot care, renal dialysis and other community-based professionals. Examples of essential services/professions are:

Physiotherapist Social Worker

Access to these essential services is permissible when the goals of care discussions between health care team members (e.g. MRP, resident & family/substitute decision-maker, care staff) confirm this is essential.

The VCH MHO Order should not impede the provision of essential services.

On-Site Visits

- All essential services personnel:
 - Will be screened at the beginning and end of the visit, as per VCH staff screening guidelines
 - Will use full Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for Droplet Precautions e.g. wear surgical/procedure face mask, eye protection, gown and gloves and perform hand hygiene as per 4 moments of hand hygiene
- To help conserve PPE, only change a surgical/procedure mask when leaving the resident / tenant area unless it is wet, damaged or visibly dirty.
- If mask is touched, clean hands immediately.
- Eye protection (e.g. goggles) can be reused.
- Clean eye protection when leaving resident/tenant area or when visibly soiled.
- If eye protection is touched, clean hands immediately.
- Care home staff will monitor the essential services personnel donning and doffing of PPE to ensure technique and Infection Prevention and Control Guidelines are properly followed.
- Foot care nurses:
 - Will visit when deemed essential (toe nail is causing a wound and the resident has high risk comorbidities e.g. diabetes mellitus, peripheral vascular disease)
 - Will clean and disinfect surfaces used for the appointment with hospital grade disinfectant
 - Will follow sterilization of shared instruments as per reprocessing guideline
 - o Can attend multiple sites in a day; plan to visit outbreak facility/site last
