Recommended Cleaning and Disinfection for Non-Critical Care Equipment

Cleaning Agents

• Enzymatic cleaners, detergents, or soap and water

Combined Cleaning and Disinfectant Agents

Disinfectants are only to be used to disinfect and must not be used as general cleaning agents, unless combined with a cleaning agent as a onestep cleaner/disinfectant. Cleaning must always precede disinfection. Disinfectants that can be combined with a cleaning agent, often in the form of a wipe:

• Quaternary ammonium compounds (QUATS), 0.5% Accelerated hydrogen peroxide

Effective Low-Level Disinfection Agents:

• Hypochlorite (1000-5000 ppm), 0.5% Accelerated hydrogen peroxide, Quaternary ammonium compounds
