




Clinical Characteristics of Home Support Clients (65+)





Higher Risk, Less Service


Distribution of Hours per Eligible Day for Clients at Risk/Very High risk of Admission to Long-Term Care

Average Caregiver Hours vs. Service Hours Provided by Health Authorities, for Long-term Home Support Clients




AVERAGE CAREGIVER HOURS PER CLIENT

Cost Burden for Seniors


SINGLE SENIOR ANNUAL INCOME	\$29,000
INCOME TAX	\$1,100
HOUSING	\$17,200
FOOD	\$5,200
HEALTH EXPENSES	\$3,100
HOME SUPPORT	\$8,900
CLOTHING/PERSONAL COSTS	\$3,400
TELECOMMUNICATIONS	\$1,800
TOTAL EXPENSES	\$40,700
REMAINING INCOME	-\$11,700

A senior with a **\$29,000 income** will pay **31%** of their income, nearly **\$9,000/year,** for **one hour** of home support per day.




Premature Admission to Long-Term Care

Cost of Home Support vs. Long-Term Care

Scenario of Estimated Cost to Health Authority of Fully Subsidized Home Support (1 HR) vs. Long-Term Care (LTC) for a Single Senior per year

SINGLE SENIOR ANNUAL INCOME	\$29,000	
	HOME SUPPORT (1 HR)	LTC
ESTIMATED COST	\$14,100	\$82,100
CLIENT CONTRIBUTION	REGULATED FEE ELIMINATED	\$22,200
COST TO HEALTH AUTHORITY	\$14,100	\$59,900
