Long-Term Care Waits Increasing

- Nearly 6,500 people waiting for long-term care • (**150%** over 5 yrs.)
- People admitted **2.5X** faster from hospital than community
- In community, non-urgent clients waited **3X** longer • than the urgent clients.

Assisted Living Waits Increasing

- 4,300 publicly-subsidized assisted living units vs.
 28,000 publicly-subsidized long-term care beds
- **1,200** people waiting for publicly-subsidized assisted living (**37%**↑ over 5 yrs.)





Less Access to Home Support

Over the last 5 yrs.

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
SENIORS ADVOCATE

- **11%**↑ in people receiving home support
- **7%**↓ in client rate per 1,000 pop. 75+
- Senior with an annual income of \$30,000, pays \$9,000 for one hour of home support per day (nearly 30% of income)
- Most provinces **do not charge for home support**, incl. Ontario and Alberta
- **56%**↑ in Better at Home waitlist

Affordable Housing Unavailable

Seniors' Subsidized Housing

- Nearly **14,000** applications (**59%**↑ over 5 yrs.)
- **6%** of applicants received a unit
- **61%**↑ in waitlist over 5 yrs.
- **17%** applicants waiting 5+ yrs.
- **3%**↑ in units over 5 yrs.
- 4.5%↓ in number of units per 1,000 seniors (55+) over 5 yrs.





Housing Subsidies Decreasing

Shelter Aid for Elderly Renters (SAFER)

Over 5 yrs.

- **8%**↓ in SAFER recipients
- **18%** ↓ in client rate per 1,000 people
- **7%**↓ in avg. monthly subsidy **(\$192)**
- **13%**↑ in avg. monthly rent
- SAFER program not meeting goal of low-income seniors only paying 30% of income towards rent





Transportation

Driving

 88% of seniors 65-74 have an active drivers licence (10%↑ over 5 yrs.)

Public Transportation

- **65,000** seniors have a BC Bus Pass (**17%**个)
- **44%**↑ in unfulfilled HandyDart ride requests over 5 yrs.
- **15%** \downarrow in HandyDart rides over 5 yrs.





Seniors Safety

Over 5 yrs.

- 18%↑ in victims of violent offences 65+ reported to RCMP
- **23%**↑ in victims of assault 65+ reported to RCMP
- 88↑ in victims of fraud 65+ reported to RCMP
