NEW Ministry of Health Policy Mask Use in Health Care Facilities

- The introduction of this policy is focused on the protection of patients, clients, clinicians, health care workers, non-clinical staff and the public
- Outlines provincial expectations for the use of face masks in all health care facilities, programs and services, including community physician offices and outpatient clinics during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- It is a requirement for all LTC/AL sites to provide a medical mask to all persons coming in to the site
- Fraser Health will continue to support the procurement and provision of PPE to all LTC/AL sites

Important Clarification on Mask Use in LTC & AL

Environment	Used By	Work Environment	Type of Mask
Long-Term Care/Seniors Assisted Living Settings	Health care workers and non- clinical staff	All areas, including common areas and break rooms unless eating	A surgical/procedure mask must be worn at all times
	Visitors	All areas	A surgical/procedure mask must be worn at all times

- The policy does NOT require that all residents in LTC/AL wear a mask within the facility
- Residents who are required to wear a mask for reasons such as patient transport, medical
 appointment or other circumstances as directed by Medical Health Officer, should wear a medical
 grade mask, provided by the site
- Visitors to LTC/AL are now required to wear a medical grade mask and this should be provided by the site
- *Note this policy does NOT apply to Independent Living (IL) unless the IL site is intermingled with assisted living
- The policy is attached again (this version is the same but on a BCCDC/Ministry of Health template)
